




# **Automated Commercialised Environment (ACE) Air**

## What is ACE Air?

The Automated Commercial Environment (ACE) was introduced by the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP). This initiative is a cargo inventory control and release notification system for ocean, air, highway and rail carriers. ACE Air allows carriers to "arrive" an in-bond shipment and to file in-bond, permit to proceed, and local transfers electronically.

## **How It Works?**

With Global eTrade Services (GeTS) ACE Air, the carrier and freight forwarder obtains notifications of, such as in-bond authorizations, general order, permit to proceed, and local transfer authorization upon flight departure or arrival from the last foreign port. Airway bill data can be transmitted in any sequence. GeTS ACE Air increases data reliability and electronic enforcement capability by standardizing the way the trade community and Customs communicate.

# Section 321

## What is Section 321?

A Section 321 entry is a type of informal entry that allows the release of goods valued at \$800 or less. To be released under a Section 321, the shipment must not exceed \$800 in value and must not be one of several lots covered by a single order or contract. Section 321 entries may be claimed in conjunction with an eManifest filing, subsequently reducing paperwork for low-value goods and allow faster clearance processing

Brokers and importers simply upload the file with Section 321 entries, and the application will populate the data to the eManifest and submit the form directly to CBP.

## Section 321 Entry Requirements and **Product Restrictions:**

Many products cannot be imported using section 321 regardless of value. Items requiring inspection as a condition of release are merchandise subject to Anti-Dumping / Countervailing duty (ADD/CVD), and certain products regulated by the following Partner Government Agencies (PGAs), may not qualify under Section 321

- · Food and Drug Administration (FDA)\*
- Food Safety Inspection Service (FSIS)
- National Highway Transport and Safety Administration (NHTSA)
- Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSA)
- United States Department of Agriculture (USDA)

\*FDA Exceptions for filing Section 321

- · Biological samples for laboratory testing
- Dinnerware, cosmetics
- Radiation-emitting non-medical devices
- Food (excluding ackees, puffer fish, raw clams, raw oysters, raw mussels, and food packed in airtight containers stored at room temperature
